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## Preschool Communication Screening Checklist

There are several signs and symptoms that can indicate challenges with communication. The purpose of this form is to help determine if a formal evaluation by a speech language pathologist is indicated. Please check any of the signs and symptoms your child or student may demonstrate.

- ☐ Difficulty understanding differences in meaning ("go-stop," "in-on," "big-little," "up-down")
- ☐ Challenges pointing to body parts
- ☐ Struggling to learn colors
- ☐ Difficulty following two step requests
- ☐ Challenges listening to books when being read
- ☐ Wants to turn the pages in books before the reader has finished reading
- ☐ Enjoys talking about the pictures in a book but does not like to listen to the story
- ☐ Understands less than 500-900 words
- ☐ Does not have a word for almost everything in the familiar environment
- ☐ Difficulty communicating wants and needs
- ☐ Challenges asking for objects or communicating information
- ☐ Uses less than 2 – 3 words in most sentences
- ☐ Uses less than 3 – 4 words in most sentences
- ☐ Picky eater
- ☐ Speech is difficult to understand for family or new listeners
- ☐ Challenges answering simple "wh" questions (who, what, where, and why)
- ☐ Repeats syllables or words when talking
- ☐ Difficulty talking about activities at school or at friends' homes
- ☐ Speech is difficult to understand for strangers
- ☐ Does not like to try new foods
- ☐ Difficulty hearing and understanding most of what is said at home and in school
- ☐ Challenges communicating with other children and/or adults
- ☐ Difficulty paying attention to a short story
- ☐ Difficulty saying the following sounds: \_\_\_\_\_
- ☐ Gags, chokes, or coughs when eating or drinking
- ☐ Challenges answering simple questions after reading a book or watching a show
- ☐ Struggles to use sentences that give details (the big dog, the red car)
